



Annual Membership Renewal Requirements

1. Pay Annual Membership Fees (\$25)
2. Complete and return the Renewal Application
3. Indicate if you have had an address, email, or phone number change on the application.
4. Follow the Oak Ridge Kennel Club Code of Ethics

If you would like to receive reduced class fees and have access to the ORKC campus for practice/training you must comply with this every year:

1. Attend at least two (2) club membership meetings: virtually or in-person every year.
2. Complete a minimum of 10 (ten) hours of volunteer service to the club, on an annual basis.
3. Hours and meetings attended are to be tracked using the spreadsheet on the members only portion of the website.
4. Send your completed spreadsheet to the Training Director.

Volunteering:

- Maintenance of the ORKC buildings/property and conducting dog events are labor intensive activities. We cannot schedule or host trials and shows WITHOUT volunteers.
- Please note any special talents and/or abilities that you want to share with ORKC: teaching, stewarding, maintenance, cleaning, chairing committees, word processing, maintenance, judging.
- There are many opportunities to perform volunteer service which will depend on your skills and the club's needs.
- If you have a valid reason that you cannot perform any volunteer hours for the Club, please submit a letter and documentation to me or one of the ORKC Officers or Board members. My email is orkcmembershipchair@gmail.com Other communication information is on the members only page of the website.

You must submit the renewal form and annual dues of \$25 for 2026 by January 1, 2026 to maintain your eligibility for member benefits. Do not leave your form and payment in the black box. To maintain the goals and standards of the Club, members of The Oak Ridge Kennel Club agree to adhere to By-Laws, Rules, Regulations, and Policies of the Club and to also follow the Code of Ethics as listed below:

1. Be dedicated to creating an environment at the Club that is friendly, fun, inviting, educational and supportive.

3. Always remember that they and their dogs are representatives of the Club both private and public events.
4. Conduct themselves in a fashion that upholds the goals and standards of ORKC.
5. Ensure that their dogs are always kept safe and under control.
6. Properly train their dogs so that they are not a nuisance or disturbance to other dogs and handlers when attending Club or any functions, but rather exemplify canine good citizen behavior and are an asset to the community.
7. Appreciate the efforts of all club members.
8. Are supportive of new and current members of the Club.
9. Deal fairly and considerately at all times with members, handlers and dogs, as well as those who participate in the Club's programs and events.
10. Harassment, abusive language, and abusive behavior will not be tolerated by either members or non-members. Abusive language, behavior and cruelty to animals is a direct violation of this Code.

Members who are in violation of the Code of Ethics and/or Good Sportsmanship as set forth by AKC, are subject to disciplinary action per Article VI of the Constitution.
